

Back to School Night Talking Points for RCBC CAP teachers

- Each CAP class is only \$150 (this includes all 3- or 4-credit college courses). For LRHSD courses that are equivalent to two CAP courses, tuition is \$300 (e.g. Television Broadcasting Technology II is RCBC ETV 101 and ETV 105, 7 credits, \$300).
- No additional fees (e.g. textbooks or activity fees) will be collected.
- Many in-state and out-of-state colleges accept credit earned through a CAP program.
- CAP is not intended to replace the Advanced Placement program (although a student who does not earn college credit via an AP test could earn CAP credit if applicable).
- RCBC will only grant credit if the student earns a "C" or better in the course. Students should sign up for CAP credit if they have a reasonable expectation of meeting that criterion.
- Students may only register for courses they are currently taking this school year.
- Registration is online this year through DualEnroll details in the emails, letters and website.
- Registration is final; payment for CAP classes is non-refundable once the funds are sent from the school to RCBC. RCBC will not refund students who drop a CAP course or earn a final course grade lower than C in the CAP course, or if a college does not accept CAP credit.
- It is recommended you research policies of colleges you are considering and find out if your CAP credit will transfer. RCBC will submit a final transcript, upon request, to any higher education institution.
- CAP Scholarships are available to students who qualify for the Free/Reduced Lunch program.
- All CAP information, as well as the list of CAP courses, was emailed to parents of students in CAP courses on Wednesday, Oct. 3rd. Hard copies of the CAP letter are also being mailed home.
